A BIG WEEKEND – With three packed shows Dec. 15 and 16, Dancing for a Cure's 7th Annual Holiday event at the Barnstable High School raised approximately \$45,000 for its partner, Friends of Dana-Farber, Boston. The organization donates 100 percent of proceeds to the research of ovarian and breast cancer as well as local support of cancer patients here on Cape Cod. The weekend of events included tickets sales, silent auctions, opportunity baskets, merchandise and more. It was enough to top this year's goal of exceeding \$200,000 in total fundraising since Dancing for a Cure was founded in 2006. This year's show was dedicated to the memory of Karen S.
